PRIVACY POLICY

We have created this privacy policy statement in order to demonstrate our firm commitment to your privacy. The following discloses our information gathering, use and dissemination practices solely for the web site located at http://www.normanpearlstine.com, the web site about Norman Pearlstine's book, "Off the Record" (the "Site").
